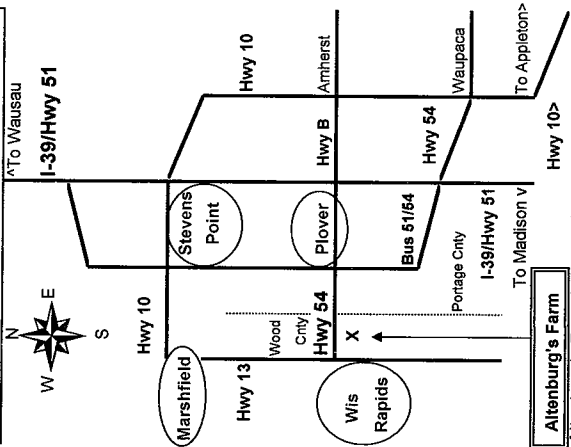

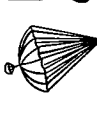

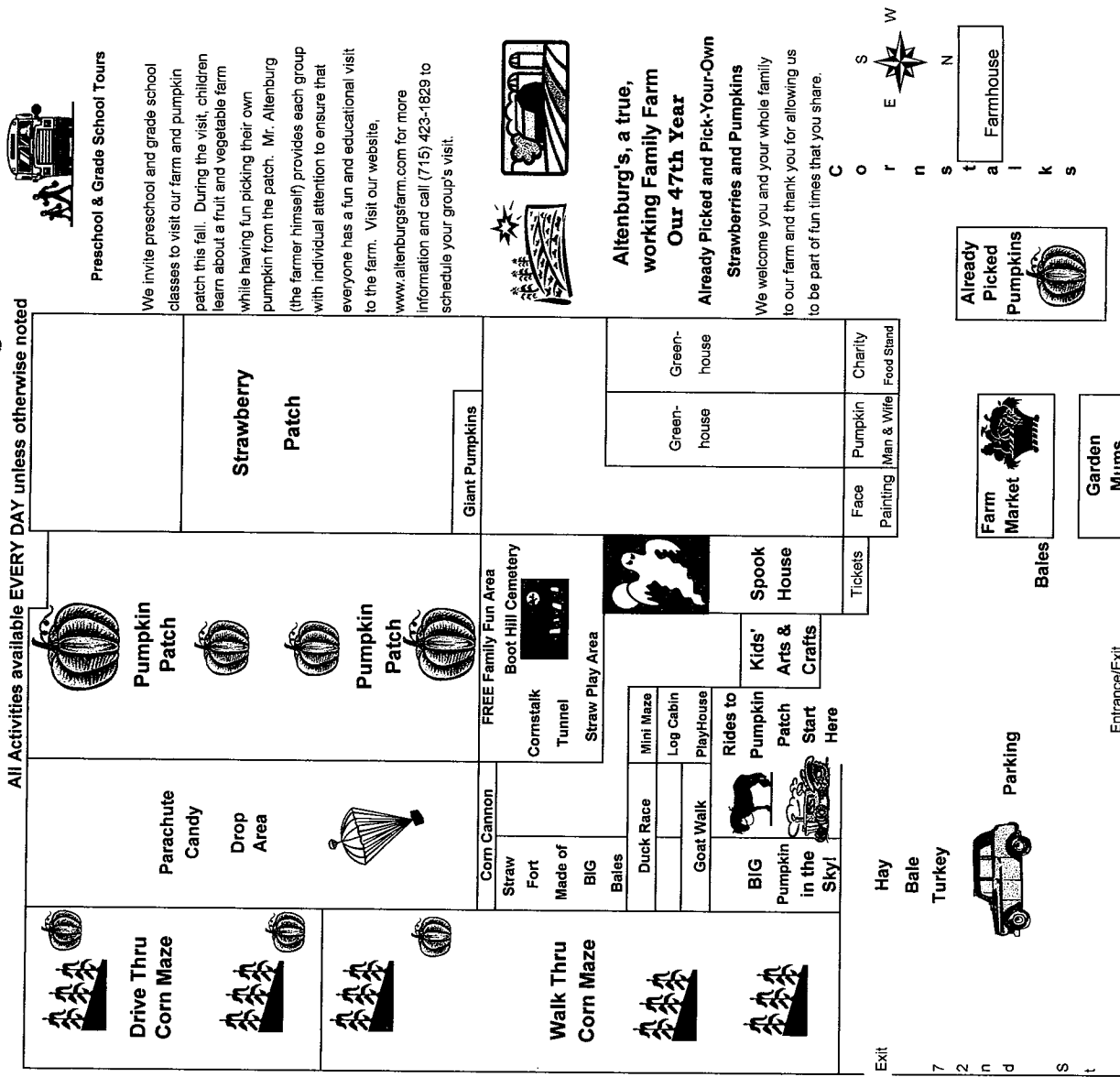

Preschool & Grade School Tours

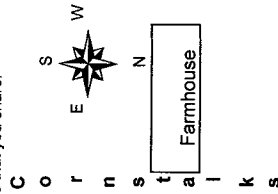
